The couples selected by the National Team to attend the event will be contacted directly by the National Office. **You must have the following information ready when you ring:** *Name, contact address, email and mobile number(s); date of planned or recent sacramental marriage (within the past twelve months) and the church in which the marriage will take place or has taken place; Confirmation that you as a couple are available to attend the meeting with Pope Francis on Saturday, 25th August.*
