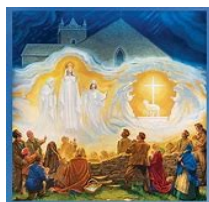

In May last year more volunteers were trained and commissioned to continue this Ministry in the parish.

On **Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> June** commencing at **2.30pm**, there will be a **Liturgy of Blessing and Anointing for our Sick and housebound parishioners, and their carers** in the Iona Room. This will be followed by refreshments and there will be time to meet up with our guests and to assure them they have not been forgotten.

If you are aware of anyone who is not on the Parish list of Sick & Housebound please let us know if they would like to attend. Helpers are needed as some people will need wheelchair assistance, we will need drivers and volunteers to help us make sure they are comfortable and safe in the Church and help them over to the Iona Room and to cars, also to make and serve tea & coffee.
