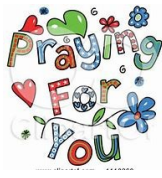


EXAM SUPPORT

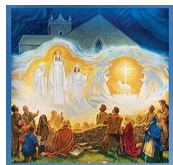

There are over thirty parishioners that we are aware of, who through infirmity or frailty are housebound in private homes or Nursing Homes. This prevents them participating in parish Liturgies and social activities and many can be lonely. Some parishioners have for many years brought out Holy Communion to the Sick &

Housebound and they deserve our thanks. In May last year more volunteers were trained and commissioned to continue this Ministry in the parish.

On **Saturday 15th June** commencing at **2.30pm**, there will be a **Liturgy of Blessing and Anointing for our Sick and housebound parishioners, and their carers** in the Iona Room. This will be followed by refreshments and there will be time to meet up with our guests and to assure them they have not been forgotten.

Helpers are needed as some people will need wheelchair assistance, we will need drivers and volunteers to help us make sure they are comfortable and safe in the Church and help them over to the Iona Room and to cars, also to make and serve tea & coffee.
