## LITURGY OF ANOINTING THE SICK AND HOUSEBOUND

**Saturday 15th June 2019**

**On Saturday afternoon about twenty five Sick and Housebound parishioners, as well as their carers, family members and parishioners, gathered in St Colmcille's.**



Fr Vincent presided at a liturgy during which he moved slowly among the sick, some in wheel chairs, others sitting with their Carers and as he did so he anointed them on the forehead with the Oil of the Sick. Then he moved among the Carers, tracing the sign of the cross on their palms praying that they would always be there for the sick, like the gentle and caring hands of Christ. Meanwhile, the choir

sang **"Lay Your Hands Gently upon us"** as two Ministers of Holy Communion distributed the Eucharist to those who wished to receive it.
