In the GOSPEL TODAY

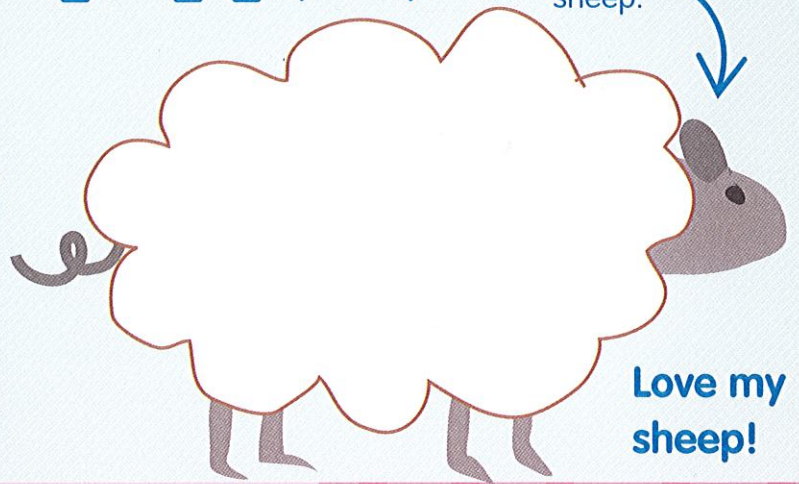

Jesus' sheep

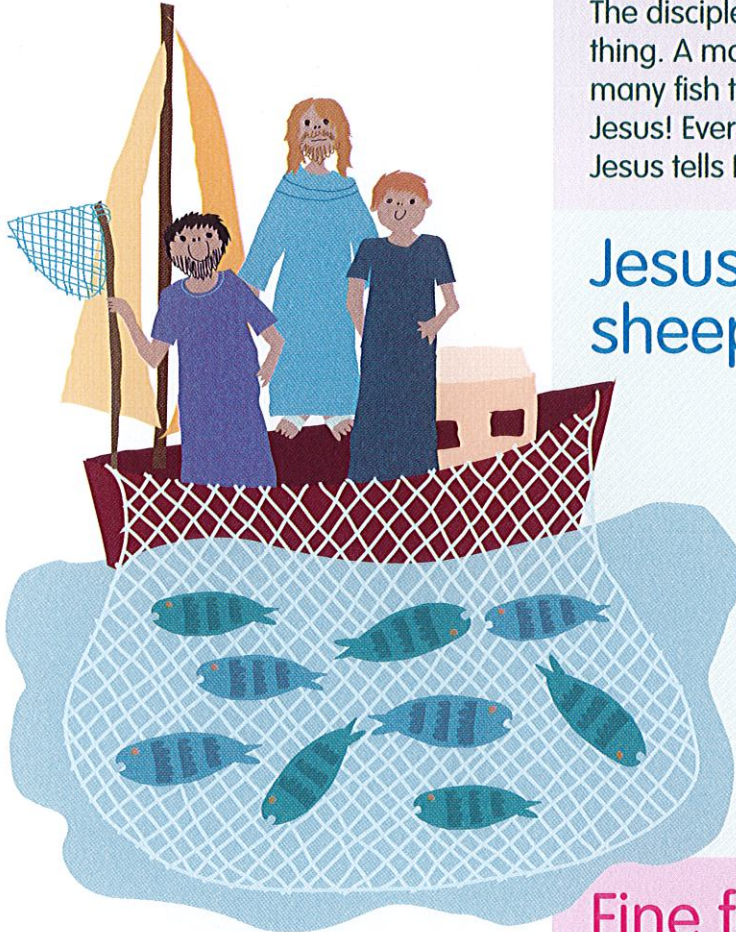

Love my sheep!



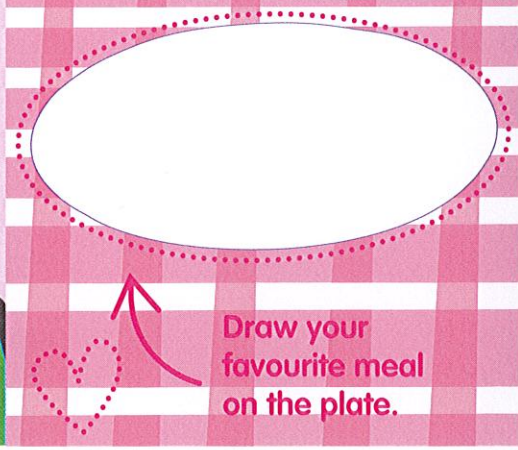
How many fish?

Jesus cooked fish for the disciples.



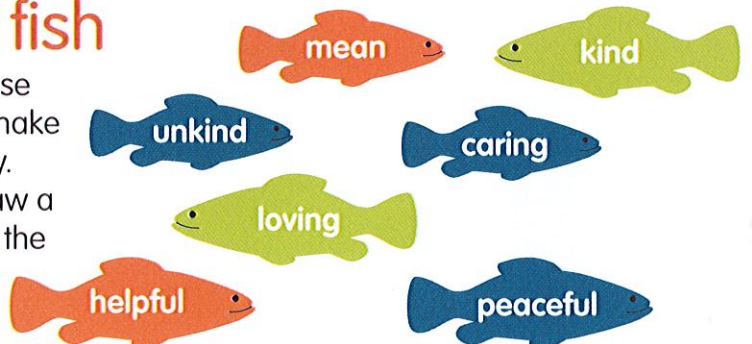
Draw your favourite meal on the plate.
