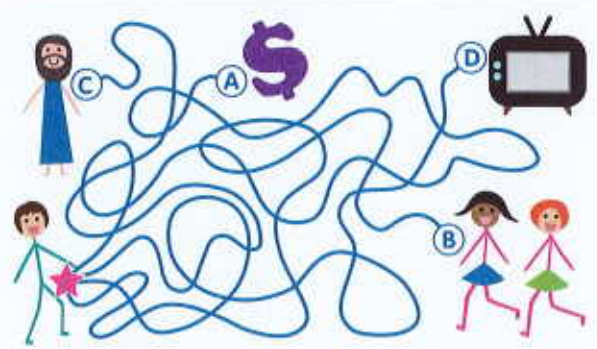
Which of these people is being like Jesus? Put a circle round anyone you think is being a disciple and copying what they have learned about Jesus.

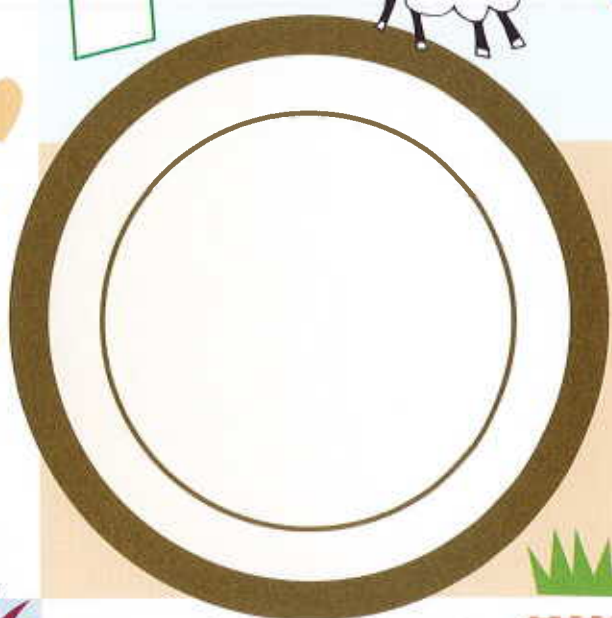


### Where is the coin?

**Sharing** makes us **happy**. Make this face like you with hair, freckles or glasses. Draw a happy smile on your face!



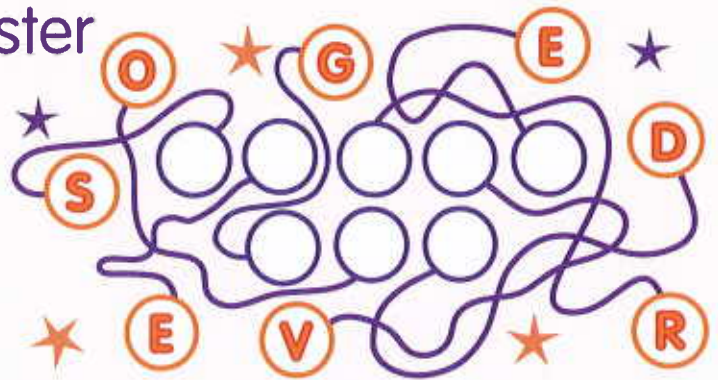
### A PRAYER TO SAY

Jesus gives us a special message in today's Gospel. Move each letter to its linked empty circle to see what it is.



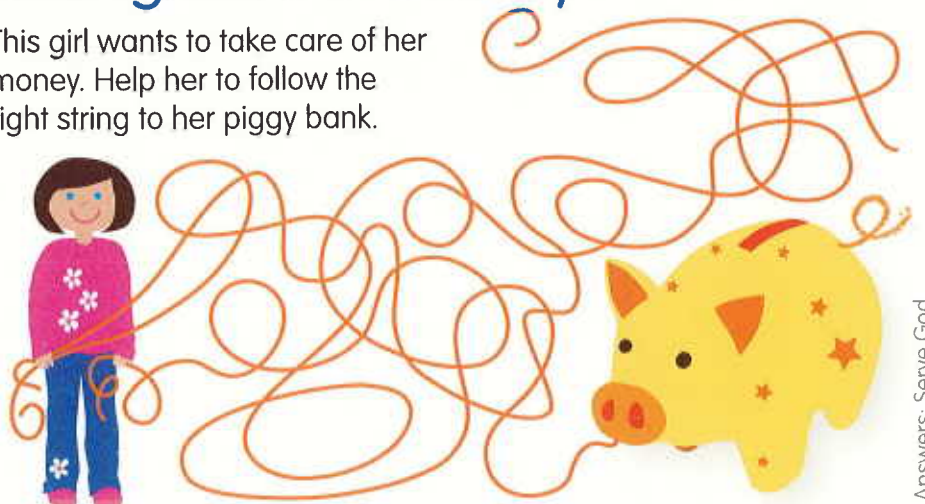

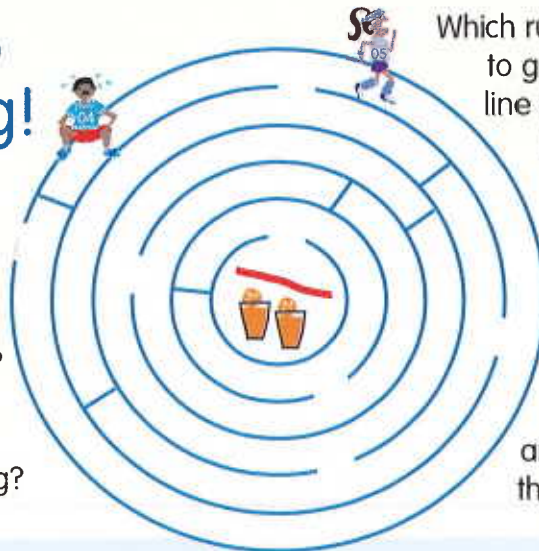
