MORNING AND EVENING PRAYER OF THE CHURCH



The New Testament leaves us in no doubt that we should pray regularly, both alone and with others. Over many centuries, to enable communal prayer, the Church introduced the Liturgy of the Hours, to be prayed together at set times during the day. This gradually evolved into the book of Divine Office, in which the traditional elements of Christian prayer were arranged and organised. Originally, the Divine Office was only for those who were ordained or in religious life, but in the 1960s Pope Paul VI extended it to all members of the Church. Morning and Evening Prayer is a shortened

version of the Divine Office, and it will be re-introduced in St. Colmcille's on the evening of Ash Wednesday, 22nd February, at 7pm. In subsequent weeks Morning Prayer will take place in the church on Mondays at 9.30am, and Evening Prayer on Wednesdays at 7pm. Everyone is welcome to participate in this historic and spiritual form of prayer, even if you are unable to come to every session. Booklets will be provided to assist you in becoming familiar with the very beautiful psalms and songs of the Church.
