LAUDATIO SI GROUP

In a meeting at the Vatican on Jan. 19, the Pope defined "ecological conversion" as "true repentance" that leads to the end of "ideologies and practices that are hurtful and disrespectful to the earth." Pope Francis said that it requires people to commit to "promoting models of developments that heal wounds inflicted by greed, excessive search for financial profits, lack of solidarity with neighbours, and disrespect for the environment. He continued: "For their part, Christians fulfill their ecological responsibility when, as trustworthy stewards, they protect creation, the work God has entrusted to them 'to till and to keep" (Gen 2:15; cf. Laudato Si', 95; 217).
