Dear Sisters and Brovers,

The Church dedicates the month of May in a special way to Our Blessed Mother, Mary. It is a time of grace, beauty, and devotion, when the blossoming of nature around us reflects the life and joy that Mary brings to the heart of the Church. During this month, we are invited to renew our love for her and to grow closer to Jesus through her motherly care.

One simple way to honour Mary in our homes is by creating a small Marian altar or shrine. This could be as easy as placing a statue or image of Our Lady in a quiet corner, adding some flowers, a candle, or a Rosary. It becomes a gentle daily reminder of her presence and a prompt to pause, reflect, and pray.

The Rosary itself is one of the most beautiful prayers we can offer during this month. If a full Rosary seems too much, why not begin with just a single decade each day? Even five minutes of quiet prayer can bring immense peace. As we meditate on the mysteries of Jesus' life through Mary's eyes, we allow her to teach us how to follow Him more closely.

A count of attendance will take place at all Masses across the Diocese NEXT weekend, 10th and 11th May 2025.
