Dear Sisters and Boders,

What a Week! Some weeks are full of grace—and this past one was overflowing. It began with the Alpha Conference in London on Monday and Tuesday, where I joined 5,000 Christian leaders from across denominations and across the world. It was two days of powerful worship, inspiring speakers, deep prayer, and a sense of real hope for the Church. One moment that really stood out was hearing about the dramatic growth in faith among young people. In 2018, just 4% of 18–24 year-olds in the UK attended church. Now, in 2024, that number has jumped to 16%. Among young men, the figure has risen from 4% to 21%; among young women, from 3% to 12%. It's not just national data—it reflects what we're seeing here in St Colmcille's too. Young hearts are opening to God. The Spirit is moving.



Then, in what can only be described as a moment of joyful madness, I booked a last-minute flight and flew to Rome for the day on the hunch that we might have a new pope elected on Thursday. And we did! I found myself in St Peter's Square surrounded by thousands of Catholics from every corner of the world as the white smoke rose and the name Pope Leo XIV was announced—the first American pope in history, and with Irish roots too! The atmosphere was electric: cheers, hymns, flags, prayers, tears, and smiles all around. It was a moment I will never forget, and an honour to have been there for it.

God is so good. The Church is alive and full of surprises. Viva il Papa

Pilgrimage to Knock Shrine Sunday 25th May 2025


